Pouca Roupa Branco, João Portugal Ramos   **£27.00**
Alentejo, Portugal 2021

An aromatic and refreshing Portuguese blend with notes of citrus and tropical fruits.

Thomas Stopfer Gemischter Satz  **£36.00**
Wagram, Austria 2020

Flowery fragrant fruit components on the nose, with delicate scented aromas and underlying citrus notes on the palate, accompanied by a long and aromatic finish.

Domaine Hatzimichalis   **£37.00**
Lefkos, Greece 2021

An interesting blend that creates a wine that balances pronounced acidity with creamy tropical overtones. Topped with refreshing aromas of white blossom and botanical notes to help create a well-rounded wine.

Château Megyer Hárslevelu  **£38.00**
Tokaj, Hungary 2014

Ever tried 100% Hárslevelu? This fresh crisp and slightly savoury Hungarian grape is a delight. With peach and apricot fruity flavours on the nose leading to a crisp refreshing palate. A very good example of what a pure Hárslevelu should taste like.

Made of the grape Hondarrabi Zuri (try pronouncing this after a few glasses). A lively light wine with a little spritz. This is a very refreshing a unique and interesting wine from the Pays Basque.

Victoria, Australia 2017

Verdelho from Australia? The grape variety that is most associated with Portugal and makes up one of the four noble Madeira grapes. Finds its way into the very capable hands of veteran winemaker David Traeger. Guava and stone fruit aromas with a touch of ripe melon, rose petal and lychee.

Etyeki Kuria Zenit  £46.00
Észak-Dunántúl, Hungary 2021

Head wine maker Sándor Mérész has been shaping the unique style of their wines, aligning local experiences and grape varieties with his own international approach winning the 'winemakers winemaker' award in Hungary every year since 2013. This is a crisp and refreshing wine with notes of ripe lemon, flowers and peach.

Wirsching Silvaner Trocken £46.00
Franken, Germany 2020

Due to a unique microclimate created by forests and heat retaining soils, Wirching are able to create some of the most expressive, refreshing Silvaner in all of Germany. A fresh herbaceous nose combined with elegant minerality.

Jim Barry Assyrtiko   £55.00
Clare Valley, Australia 2021

Dominio de Tares El Paisano de Tares   **£31.00**
Bierzo, Spain 2021

Just drinking this glass of this wine makes you feel cool, blurring the lines between red and rose! It's a very interesting blend of Mencía, Garnacha Tintorera, Palomino Fino, Doña Blanca & Godello. Fresh and fruity. Ask for an ice bucket with this one as trying it slightly chilled is strongly recommended.

WALT Pinot Noir **£32.00**
Pfalz, Germany 2020

Walt Pinot Noir is elegant, light and fruity. it's almost too easy drinking, making the second bottle seem inevitable.

Thomas Stopfer Zweigelt Classic  **£33.00**
Wagram, Austria 2018

The estate is located in the municipality of Ruppersthal in the lower Austrian wine region, Wagram. This traditional family has been practising viticulture here for several generations. Today the operation is managed by Thomas Stopfer. A bright palate with fresh acidity, and crunchy redcurrant and raspberry fruit.

Shumi Winery Saperavi    **£35.00**
Kakheti Region, Georgia 2020

This wine is strongly developed and complex with a palate of dark fruits such as black cherries and blackberries, with underlying earthy notes and savoury spices.

Merul Mavrud, Rumelia Winery  **£36.00**
Thracian Valley, Bulgaria 2018

Made from 100% Mavrud a local dark, thick skinned Bulgarian grape which produces full bodied powerful wines. Distinctive blackberry and mulberry notes come to the forefront of this wine alongside notes of cacao and chocolate.



Korona Egri Bikaver   **£38.00**
Eger, Hungary 2019

This family run winery from the Eger wine region have been making wine for generations. Egri Bikaver translates to 'bull's blood' so naturally this wine has a strong depth of flavours, wild cherries, spices, black pepper and warm tannins.

Espadeiro Asorei   **£39.00**
Rias Baixas, Spain 2020

Espadeiro is one of Galicia's unique grapes, with only 1,800 bottles of this wine made in 2020, this is a must try. Super smooth and elegant, with ripe cherry, berries and a long fresh finish.

Arbois   £45.00
Jura, France 2020

Medium bodied and lighter in colour. This wine frames the varietal character of Trousseau beautifully, with soft, honeyed fruit wrapped around a bright red cherry.

Bodega Benegas 'Single Vineyard' Sangiovese £49.00
Mendoza, Argentina 2019

A taste of Tuscany from Mendoza, Sangiovese is the primary grape variety used in Chianti, lifted and floral with notes of cherry, tomato leaf, dried herbs and violets. This wine from a top producer really shows off the diverse styles that Mendoza can offer.

Bekaa Valley, Lebanon 2017

Cabernet Sauvignon, Carignan and Cinsault blend, you can expect big flavours from this famous wine, it can be enjoyed young or cellared for many years to come. This vintage displays notes of dried cherry, blackberry, baking spice, and sandalwood followed by carefully integrated ripe tannins.
